Air Pollution Control Advisory Council Schedules Public Hearing

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Air Pollution Control Air Advisory Council and the North Dakota Department of Health have scheduled a public hearing to address proposed changes to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules and State Implementation Plan for the control of air pollution. The public hearing will be held Oct. 7, 2008, at 9 a.m. in the Fourth Floor Conference Room of the Gold Seal Center, 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, N.D.

The primary amendments to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules include:

- Requirements for demonstration of unavoidable malfunctions.
- Prevention of significant deterioration.
- Ambient air quality standards.

The public also may submit written comments about the changes by Oct. 18, 2008. The public is invited to direct their comments to Tom Bachman, Division of Air Quality, North Dakota Department of Health, 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, ND 58501-1947.

The Air Pollution Control Advisory Council is a nine-member panel that considers and makes recommendations regarding the adoption, amendment or repeal of rules and standards pertaining to North Dakota air quality.
