Air Pollution Control Advisory Council Schedules Meeting

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Air Pollution Control Advisory Council will meet Monday, July 17, 2006, at the North Dakota Department of Health, Gold Seal Center, 918 E. Divide Ave., Bismarck, N.D. The meeting will be held at 10:30 a.m. CDT in the Fourth Floor Conference Room.

The primary topics to be discussed are amendments to the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules, including:

- Mercury reduction from power plants.
- Regional Haze Program requirements.
- Air Toxics rules

The Air Pollution Control Advisory Council is a nine-member panel that considers and makes recommendations to the Department of Health regarding the adoption, amendment or repeal of rules and standards pertaining to North Dakota's air quality.
