Tracy Miller Named State Epidemiologist

BISMARCK, N.D. – Tracy Miller, M.P.H., has been named the new state epidemiologist with the North Dakota Department of Health, according to State Health Officer Terry Dwelle, M.D.

Miller joined the Department of Health in 1998 as the field epidemiologist in Minot, N.D. She was promoted to Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity program manager and most recently to senior epidemiologist in 2005. As state epidemiologist, Miller will take the lead in coordinating and conducting the surveillance and investigation of communicable and infectious diseases in North Dakota.
